Traditional Giving:

The **Holt Education Foundation** is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization partnered with Holt Public Schools to sponsor innovative and enhanced teaching and learning projects in the classroom. Each year, thousands of dollars’ worth of mini-grants are awarded to classroom educators (to date, almost \$400,000 has been awarded in over 23 years). In addition, the Foundation sponsors the Margaret Livensparger Scholarship award, given annually to a high school senior who has exhibited exceptional talent in the performing arts. This foundation is run by a volunteer board and the primary fundraising projects are the annual pre-game Cookout and the Community Recognition Dinner (which also honors outstanding community volunteers, alumni and school employees).
